

Shower arm

Trim plate

Pipe fitting $-\frac{1}{2}$ " female (not supplied)

Tools required


PTFE tape

Installation


Please note: The pipework and connection method should be prepared within the ceiling

Recommended method is to secure the arm to a wall elbow which has been fixed to a wooden batten in the ceiling.

1. Fit the trim plate onto the arm then apply sufficient PTFE tape to the thread of the shower arm which will go into the ceiling.



2. Once PTFE has been applied push the shower arm into the hole in the ceiling and connect it to the elbow then turn the shower arm into the elbow until a seal is created.



3. Once fitted and checks have been carried out for leaks, push the trim plate back to the ceiling. Silicone can be applied behind to prevent moisture passing behind the trim plate.

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.
