



- Always check for pipes and wires before drilling the wall

Mirror x 1 Wall Screws x 2 Wall Plugs x 2

Only two screws and plugs are required for the installation

Tools required



INSTALLING THE MIRROR

At the back of the mirror, there are 2 hanging hooks spaced across the top. To hang the mirror, two holes are required in the wall. Before drilling, ensure that no wires or pipes are behind the wall. If unsure, seek professional advice.

- 1. Measure the distance between the centre of the two hanging points.
- 2. Make a note of the distance and mark their position on the wall. Use a spirit level to ensure that the marks are level.
- 3. Drill the 2 holes into the wall at the position marked using a suitable drill bit.
- 4. Insert the wall plugs into the holes.
- 5. Insert the screws into the wall plugs, ensuring their heads are protruding by approximately 3mm.
- 6. Check to ensure the screws line up correctly and the mirror can be safely hung from them.
- Carefully lower the mirror onto the 2 screws, ensuring that is secure and will not slide.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Never use products containing bleach or abrasive cleaners, as these will have a detrimental effect on the appearance and lifespan of the product.

Use a clean micro fiber cloth to clean the mirror.
