


- Please read these instructions thoroughly and retain for future reference

- The pipework must be flushed out to remove any debris which can affect the function of this product.


Installation

It is advised that the installation of these valves is carried out by a fully qualified plumber or advice is obtained for a suitable qualified person or plumber.


Please note: Before starting any installation, turn off the water supply.

First, ensure that the radiator is clean from debris before you start to install the valves and in conjunction with the valves, follow the radiator or towel rail installation as per the manufacturer's instructions.


1. Wrap PTFE tape clockwise around the tail thread then screw the threaded end into the radiator or towel rail.



2. Tighten the nut (on the tail thread) using an appropriate tool, usually an Allen key.



3. Attach valve and by hand and turn it to the correct position then tighten using an appropriate tool, usually a spanner.



4. Insert the pipe (at this point you will have already prepared the water supply pipes to match up with the radiator or towel rail and valve dimensions). Then tighten the nut (with the olive already in place) that holds the pipe in position.





5. Repeat for the other side then run the central heating to the radiator.

Opening and Closing

Turn the valves anticlockwise to open the valves, turn clockwise to close the valves.

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.
